5. Train all employees in environmental issues, raise awareness and actively promote the establishment of a clean and healthy environment
6. Minimise the production of waste and material wastage
7. Actively promote the use of recyclable and renewable consumable materials
8. Minimise energy wastage by promoting the efficient use of energy, water and other resources
9. Set out commitments in relation to the main areas where we have significant environmental impacts:
 - Consumable paper sourcing, through sustainable forestry and recycled qualities
 - Energy consumption
 - Greenhouse gases - carbon management and emissions in the supply chain
 - The purchase of contracted services
 - Reducing transport pollution
10. Control of emissions from operations, protecting wildlife habitats wherever possible
11. Minimise risk to the general public and employees from our operations and activities
